Dream of sipping your morning coffee while the Mediterranean shimmers in front of you? Step onto the 25 m², south-facing terrace of this Nuevo Pueblo townhouse and that's exactly the start to every day. The space is wide enough for dining and lounging zones, fitted with a built-in stone barbeque, and—best of all—has its own gate that swings straight onto the communal pool deck, so the kids (or the sangria) never have far to travel. From here the sea stretches blue to the horizon, a view shared by the living room thanks to wall-to-wall patio doors.

Inside, the layout is made for easy holidays and laid-back year-round living: an open-plan lounge-diner flows into a fully equipped kitchen; two double bedrooms come with fitted wardrobes; and there's a full family bathroom plus a separate guest cloakroom—no bathroom queues after the beach. Hot-and-cold A/C keeps the climate perfect, fibre broadband is ready for streaming, and everything's freshly painted. (There's no fireplace and no Juliet balcony, leaving more wall for art and more room for furniture.)
